Employers and others responsible for withholding income for child support play an important role in ensuring financial stability for many families counting on payments through the Child Support Program.

Electronic Solutions



Paying electronically saves time, money, and resources; **77% of payments** by employers **are made electronically**.



Several electronic payment options are available, depending on an employer's needs and capabilities.



Registering to use the electronic income withholding order process can save employers, on average, **\$4.50 per order**.



Employers' Key Responsibilities



Report new or rehired employees and certain independent contractors, terminated employees, and upcoming lump sum payments



Withhold support from income, including from lump sum payments



Enroll children in dependent health care coverage
